

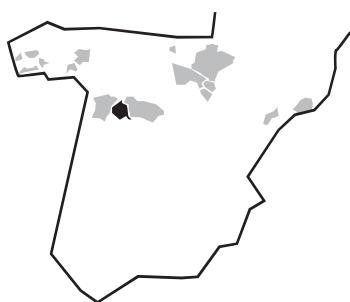

Origin

Wines from Bardos, reflect the personality of the region and respect for the vines. Wines are elegant, fresh and with a great finesse. A collection created in honour of all the men and women who dedicate their lives to the land in the hardest area of Ribera del Duero.

Varieties: Verdejo.

Vineyard: Selection of 20 to 25 years old vineyards, located in Rueda and La Seca, on the rocky soil at 700 to 800 metres above sea level. Continental climate and large temperature difference between day and night favour to produce great balance wines.

Harvest: Manually harvested during the night.

Winemaking: Cryomaceration to encourage colour and primary aromas extraction. Softly pressed with pneumatic press. Fermentation with natural grape yeasts at low temperature and aging on the fine lees for 4 months.

Alcohol Content: 13% Vol.

Tasting notes

- Colour:** Straw yellow colour with green edges.
- Nose:** Intense aroma of white fruits, citrics and cut grass with a light touch of balsamic and mineral notes.
- Palate:** The taste is fruity, fresh and elegante. It has a soft texture, nice acidity and great finish.



Early harvest of low production due to extreme weather conditions during the growing cycle. Heavy frost in Spring and severe draught in Summer reduced the quantity of a great quality fruit.
