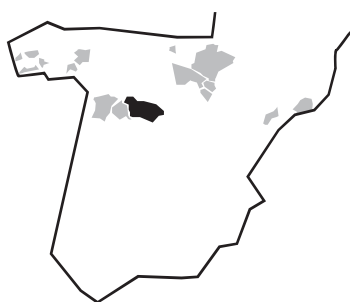

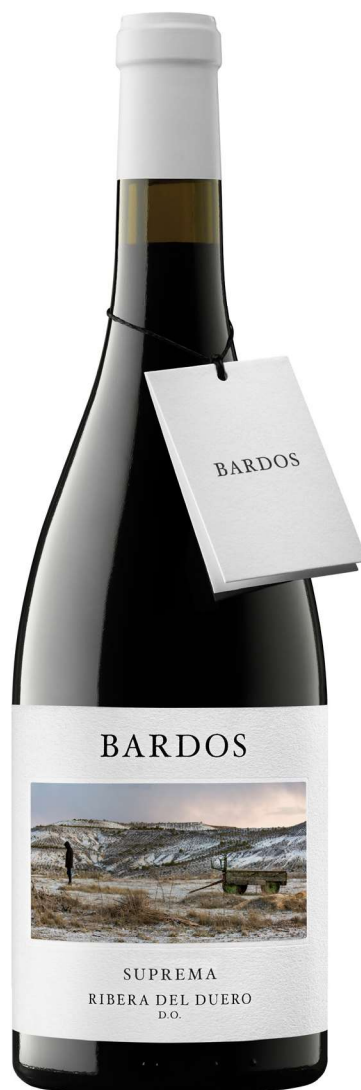

D.O. Ribera del Duero



Origin

Wines from Bardos, reflect the personality of the region and respect for the vines. Wines are elegant, fresh and with a great finesse. A collection created in honour of all the men and women who dedicate their lives to the land in the hardest area of Ribera del Duero.

Varieties: Tinta del País.

Vineyard: Old low-yield vineyards, with more than 80 years, located in the plateau of Moradillo de Roa, with an altitude of 940 metres above sea level.

Harvest: Manual harvest of selected grapes during the end of September and the beginning of October.

Winemaking: Fermentation and maceration during 3 to 4 weeks in 9,000 kg vats at 28°C. Malolactic fermentation in new French oak barrels.

Aging: More than 30 months in new French oak barrels.

Alcohol Content: 14,5% Vol.

Tasting notes



Colour: Violet black colour.



Nose: Intense, mature and powerful. It reminds of mature dark fruits, caramel, coffee, chocolate, spices and smoked wood.



Palate: Powerful wine, with the right amount of acidity, soft tannins, perfect harmony and unforgettable aftertaste.



2012 brought cold and rainy Spring followed by dry Summer months. The wines are of good color intensity, a rich concentration of aromas and good tannins.
